For 2011-2012, Bullock Creek Middle School made Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) in the tested subjects: Mathematic and Reading. For the 2011-2012 school year, students scored 86.2% in reading and 63.3% in mathematics. While we are pleased to have reached this important goal, we are continuously working to improve. Our School improvement process is designed to focus on literacy and mathematics to support our improvements. We appreciate the continued support of parents, staff and our community in this effort.

6. IDENTIFY THE NUMBER AND PERCENT OF STUDENTS REPRESENTED BY PARENTS AT PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES  
 There were approximately 450 students enrolled at Bullock Creek Middle School throughout the 2011-2012 school year. At the fall 2011 parent and teacher conference, 47.1% of the students were represented by parent(s) or

guardian(s). In the spring 2012 parent and teacher conference, 18.2% of the students were represented by parents(s) or guardian(s).

Bullock Creek Middle School is full of energy, excitement, learning opportunities and wonderful students. During the 2011-2012 school year, we had approximately 450 students in grades 6-8. This was an increase of about 20 students from the previous year and we anticipate another increase of about 30 students for the coming school year.

Our school is designed to meet the unique needs of middle school students. A middle school is a special place where students experience the transition from childhood to preadolescence in human development. The school's programs recognize the physical, emotional and educational needs of these students and serve as the bridge from the self-contained elementary program to the departmentalized programs at the high school.
